** JmDNS

This is an implementation of multi-cast DNS in Java. It currently supports service discovery and service registration. It is fully interoperable with Apple's Rendezvous.

** Requirements

jmdns has been tested using the JDK 1.3.1 and JDK 1.4.0 on the following platforms:

Windows 9x, XP, 2000
Linux RedHat 7.3-9.0, Mandrake
Mac OSX

** Running jmdns from the Command Line

GUI browser:

```
java -jar lib/jmdns.jar -browse
```

TTY browser for a particular service type:

```
java -jar lib/jmdns.jar -bs _http._tcp local.
```

Register a service:

```
java -jar lib/jmdns.jar -rs foobar _http._tcp local. 1234 path=index.html
```

List service types:

```
java -jar lib/jmdns.jar -bt
```

To print debugging output specify `-d` as the first argument.
